Launching in 2025, Pure Amazon is our first riverboat in Peru, operating on the Marañón and Ucayali rivers, near where the Amazon itself starts. This state-of-the-art riverboat offers three-, four- and seven-night itineraries exploring the Pacaya-Samiria National Reserve, a 21,000-square-kilometre showcase of exceptional natural beauty in the remote north of the country.

Pure Amazon has 12 exceptionally elegant, architect-designed suites and cabins, a superb indoor-outdoor restaurant serving local and international dishes, Jacuzzi, Sun Deck, and a wellness space. A maximum of 22 passengers per cruise and a staff-to-guest ratio of one-to-one guarantee an intimate, highly focused and personalised experience, in which every detail is managed by a best-in-class local team.

SUITES, CABINS AND FACILITIES

Pure Amazon has 12 suites and cabins, meticulously designed by renowned architect Adriana Granato:

- 10 Double Suites, for couples and friends
- 2 Single Cabins, perfect for independent travellers

Four of the 10 Double Suites can be connected, creating two sets of interconnecting suites, ideal for families with children. For those requesting an interconnecting family suite, an additional bed can also be provided should a triple be required (children only).

All suites and cabins are fully air-conditioned and have panoramic windows, minibar and tablets, along with a private bathroom with shower, amenities and hairdryer.

Pure Amazon has an upper Sun Deck (with Jacuzzi), shaded Veranda Lounge bar, gym and spa treatment room. On the promenade deck, Pure Amazon's restaurant can seat up to 26 guests.

DINING

Breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea and dinner are included in your stay, as well as all alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. Prebreakfast tea and coffee is available to early risers. Room service is also available on request.

Meals typically consist of the following:

- · Breakfast: international buffet and à la carte Peruvian
- Lunch: buffet style (international, barbecue and Peruvian)
- Afternoon tea: selection of pastries, cookies and fresh fruit
- Dinner: à la carte or table d'hôte menus

LOCATION AND GETTING THERE


Pure Amazon departs from Nauta, where the Marañón and Ucayali meet to create the Amazon River in northern Peru. To reach Nauta, guests will fly from Lima to Iquitos, where guests will be transferred to Nauta in an exclusive Pure Amazon vehicle.

• Iquitos to Nauta – 1 hour 45 minutes

FLORA AND FAUNA

Pure Amazon operates in and around the Pacaya-Samiria National Reserve, Peru's largest protected area – 21,000 square kilometres, about the size of Vermont or Wales – and a place of quite exceptional beauty and biodiversity. Even in the broader context of the Amazon Basin as a whole, it is renowned as a hotspot of flora and fauna.

Expert-led excursions on motorised skiffs take place twice a day, morning and evening, safari-style. Depending on the season, river jaunts may be interspersed with forays on foot into the rainforest or visits to small villages of *ribereños*, the local river-dwellers. June to November is low-water season. Birders and wildlife lovers will not wish to miss the opportunity to venture into the habitat of some of the rarest and most iconic species on earth. Eyes peeled for the rufescent tiger heron, white-chinned jacamar, saddle-backed tamarin, three-toed sloth... In high-water season, from December to May, the Amazon and its tributaries the Marañón and Ucayali flood, and most of the Pacaya-Samiria reserve is submerged. Though this may sound limiting, and in a literal sense is limiting, in fact it also opens up a perspective on the entire land- and riverscape that is nothing less than enchanted.

Note that wildlife sightings are of course subject to time of day, conditions, seasons, migratory patterns and luck.


DAY 1: IQUITOS - EMBARKATION

Arrival and embarkation: Begin your adventure in the provincial capital, Iquitos, where you'll be met and escorted via an exclusive Pure Amazon transfer to the town of Nauta, our embarkation point close to where the Marañón and Ucayali rivers meet to create the Amazon river. WHAT TO PACK

Clothing should be cool and comfortable. For excursions, neutral tones are best: khaki, green, brown and beige, in lightweight, breathable fabrics (cotton or moisture-wicking material). Evening dress on board Pure Amazon is smartcasual. Formalwear is not required but shorts and T-shirts are not permitted at dinner.

Among the most practical items to pack are:

- · Long-sleeved shirts and long trousers
- Short-sleeved shirts and shorts
- · Sandals or flip-flops
- Sun hat and sunglasses
- Swimsuit
- · Cameras, chargers

Note that ponchos, rubber boots, binoculars, sunblock and insect repellent will be provided for guided walks.


PURE AMAZON DECK PLAN

Note that suites are convertible and can be configured as a double or twin.


